

Currently she holds the position of Artistic Director of the international Festival Fabbrica Europa in Florence, developing the international activity of Fondazione Fabbrica Europa per le arti contemporanee, recognized by the Tuscany Region as multidisciplinary organism of regional relevance.

Fabbrica Europa is an interdisciplinary project focused on contemporary theatre, dance, music, visual arts and multimedia started from an idea by Maurizia Settembri and Andres Morte, who have identified the ex Stazione Leopolda in Firenze as one of the most interesting industrial archeology sites in Europe. The Festival Fabbrica Europa is a meeting place for artists and cultures from all over the world, contributing to the creation of a project strongly devoted to contemporary culture in Florence.

The festival was established in 1994 thanks to the contribution of the European Commission, the Region Tuscany, the City of Florence, the Ministry for Cultural Heritage and Activities, and can count on the collaboration of a network of operators at the local, national and international level.

She is founder and active member of Anghiari Dance Hub, a dance promotion centrw based in Anghiari, Tuscany: a structure for training and creation activities at the service of young choreographers supported by experts from different sectors. ADH offers spaces for creation residences and an effective support and promotion structure. Since 2015 she is a member of the Board of Directors.

From June 2013 to May 2014 she was Coordinator of the international activities of the NID Platform - the new platform of Italian dance held in Pisa in 2014 where more than 250 national and international operators from 30 countries took part. She also actively collaborated on the further Platforms that took place in Brescia (Oct 2015) and Gorizia (Oct 2017)
